MILITARY PARENT/GUARDIAN DATA COLLECTION FORM

The Legislature finds that, nationally, nearly two million students are from military families, where one or more parents/guardians serve in the United States Armed Forces, Reserves, or National Guard. There are approximately 130,000 military families living in Washington State. Given these facts, the Legislature has created a law (RCW 28A.300.505) requiring school districts to collect and report the military status of all families that have students attending school within the Colville School District. Reliable information about student performance will assist educators in more effectively transitioning students to a new school and/or enable school districts to implement best practices in regards to children in military families.

By filling this form out and returning it to your child's school, you will assist the district in complying with this law. More importantly, this information will allow educators to advocate for the children of military families.
